Asphalt Plant near Highway 8

Activity and Location: KGL Constructors is setting up an asphalt plant south of Highway 8 in the Transportation Utility Corridor, near the future intersection of the Southwest Calgary Ring Road (SWCRR) and Tsuut'ina Parkway (formerly Strathcona Street). The plant will provide asphalt to pave roads for the northern portion of the SWCRR.

To minimize the impact of this work on neighbouring areas, KGL will implement the following:

- The plant will use pollution controls and natural gas burners to minimize odour and emissions
- The plant will adhere to Alberta's *Code of Practice for Asphalt Paving Plants*
- The site is over a kilometre away from the nearest residence - the furthest possible location within the Transportation Utility Corridor

The site will consist of a temporary collection of equipment to produce asphalt, as well as gravel stockpiles for feedstock. It is expected to be set up in July 2017 and will be active during summer months (weather permitting). The plant will be disassembled and removed upon completion of the SWCRR.

Scheduled Completion Date: Fall 2020

Hours of Work: Monday to Saturday from 7:00 a.m. to 10:00 p.m. and Sundays and holidays from 9:00 a.m. to 10:00 p.m.
